To the parents of the Class of 2010:

It has recently been suggested that the Project Celebration Committee of 2010 offer a "buyout" option in lieu of participation in upcoming fundraising efforts. Most parents have demanding work schedules, other children, extracurricular activities, along with many other things that will be taking up much of our time in the upcoming year. The following plan is presented to everyone as an **option**.

It is determined to produce a successful Project Celebration the cost of \$100 per child is needed. At PC 2009 there were more than 400 students in attendance. The budget raised by the 2009 committee was in excess of \$40,000. Monies raised go toward venue, decorations, prizes, food and much more. This is a large event and will take **\$50,000** for our Senior class of **600** to keep them in a safe, drug and alcohol free environment after the Prom. As many of you know, it was elected that PC 2010 will be held at Alley Cats in Arlington. This alone has allowed us to free up an enormous amount of time that we will be able to spend with our children the actual day of Prom.

**We are asking that every parent donate \$100 to help defray the enormous costs and energy it takes to raise \$50,000. This is not mandatory, and any amount you can give will be gratefully accepted.**

It is our proposal to offer the ability to "buyout" for \$250, out of fund raising efforts that will still continue to take place over the year. This money will be deposited into the PC 2010 account and you can indicate if you would like to have your name removed from any future fundraising correspondence.
